



Traditional BSN Program Prerequisites

The FSU College of Nursing admits students once a year for the Fall semester. To be eligible to apply, complete the following nursing prerequisite courses. **Seven (7) of these courses must be completed at the time of application, including four (4) science courses (labs not included in the 4). All prerequisite courses must then be completed by the end of the spring semester prior to entering the program in the fall. Science prerequisite courses are indicated below with an asterisk (*).**

- Have earned an overall GPA of at least 3.4.
- Have earned an overall science GPA of at least 3.0.
- Received at least a grade of B or better in all prerequisite courses.
- Average overall GPA of admitted students is typically around a 3.7
- Average science GPA of admitted students is typically around a 3.8

Application Process:

1. Apply for admission to Florida State University at www.admissions.fsu.edu as a transfer student (for non-FSU students).
2. Apply for admission to the College of Nursing (everyone) by completing and submitting the online application at: <http://nursing.fsu.edu/Apply-to-FSU-Nursing>. Application will become available online December 1st.

***The deadline to apply is February 1st each year**

3. For non-FSU students, submit official transcript from all higher education institutions formerly attended to both the University and to the College of Nursing. Note: the College of Nursing does not receive electronic transcripts. You can mail them to:
