Nurse Educator

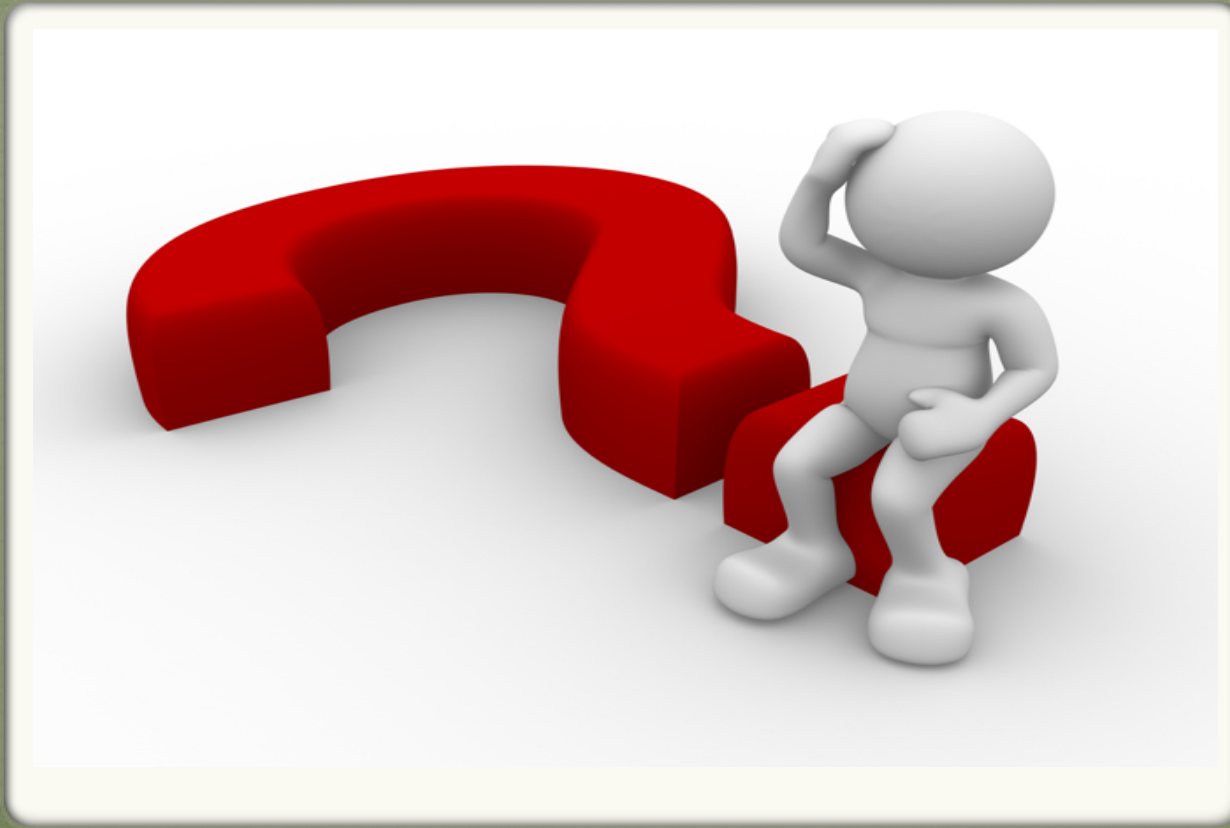
- ❖ NE is designed to prepare well-qualified nurses to become nurse educators.

Nurse Leader

- ❖ NL is designed to prepare nurse in various clinical setting to assume leadership roles within their chosen organizations
- ❖ 32 Credit hours
- ❖ 2 year part time program
- ❖ On-line

Doctor of Nursing Practice

- ❖ Family Nurse Practitioner track
 - ❖ BSN to DNP also post masters
 - ❖ 90 credit hours with 1000 clinical hours
 - ❖ Full time and part time options
 - ❖ 1st year classes on Thursday; 2nd year classes on Tuesday; 3rd year back to Thursday
 - ❖ Evidence base project in your 3rd year
 - ❖ Target acceptance in 24-28 per year
