The FSU College of Nursing admits students for the Traditional track in the Fall semester and Spring semester for the Accelerated track. To be eligible to apply, complete the following nursing prerequisite courses (or their equivalent) prior to entering the nursing program:

Half (6) of these courses must be completed at the time of application, including three (3) science courses (labs not included in the 3). All prerequisite courses and liberal studies requirements must then be completed by the end of the semester prior to entering the program. Science prerequisite courses are indicated above with an asterisk (*).

- Have earned an overall science prerequisite GPA of 3.0
- Received at least a B or better in all prerequisite courses.
