TITLE: PROGRESSION IN UNDERGRADUATE PROGRAM

POLICY: A student must achieve a 2.0 or Satisfactory (S) grades in all nursing (elective and required) courses. Any required nursing course in which a grade below 2.0 (including “U” or below 75%) is earned must be repeated.

Any student who earns two final course grades below 2.0 (including “U” or below 75%) in nursing courses whether repeated or not, will not be permitted to continue in the College of Nursing.

Students who fail to achieve the benchmark score on the mid-curricular examination on the second attempt, will be dismissed from the undergraduate nursing program.

RATIONALE: The nursing curriculum is sequenced to facilitate student learning and allow for the development of cumulative knowledge and competence. The ability to accommodate out-of-sequence students is restricted in a limited access program.

PROCEDURE:

1. A student who wishes to continue in the curriculum out-of-sequence (after an unsatisfactory course grade or a withdrawal) must petition the College of Nursing for consideration to do so.
2. The student should meet with the Associate Dean for Academic Affairs in the College of Nursing for assistance with the petition.
