The FSU College of Nursing admits students once a year for the Fall semester. To be eligible to apply, complete the following nursing prerequisite courses. Seven (7) of these courses must be completed at the time of application, including four (4) science courses (labs not included in the 4). All prerequisite courses must then be completed by the end of the spring semester prior to entering the program in the fall. Science prerequisite courses are indicated below with an asterisk (*).
