

Accelerated BSN Track Admission Requirements



Florida State University offers a one year program for those with a previous bachelor's degree in any area of study. A separate application to the College of Nursing is required for admission to the Accelerated Nursing Program, and is due July 15th prior to the following Spring semester admission.

Applicants must satisfy the following admission requirements **PRIOR** to entering the Accelerated Nursing Program:

1. Complete a baccalaureate level degree (or higher) from a regionally accredited college or university.
2. Achieve at least a 3.2 (on a 4.0 scale) cumulative GPA on all college work attempted.
3. Achieve at least a 3.0 GPA for each nursing prerequisite course taken.
4. Meet the Florida State University admission requirements for second degree seeking students. For more information, please see admissions.fsu.edu or call the Office of Admissions at 850-644-6200.
5. Complete the Florida State University *Application for Undergraduate Admission* as a transfer student.
6. Complete the *College of Nursing Accelerated Track BSN Application* at nursing.fsu.edu between May 15th and July 15th.
7. Submit a current resume.
8. Complete the following prerequisite courses with a 'B' or higher (***Only one prerequisite course can be repeated***)

All required prerequisites must be completed by the end of the summer term for admission to the following spring semester. As part of the admissions process ALL applicants that meet the minimum criteria will be required to attend a face to face, group interview during the Fall semester prior to Spring admission.
