- **Received at least a grade of C or better in all prerequisite courses.**
- **Will accept CHM1032 or CHM1033 in lieu of CHM 1045 (Chemistry for Health Science majors)**
- **Only one prerequisite course can be repeated/one time. (Lecture and labs count as individual courses when repeating)**

Application Process:

1. Apply for admission to Florida State University three months prior to the College of Nursing application deadline at www.admissions.fsu.edu as a transfer student (for non-FSU students). **You do not have to be admitted to the University to apply to the College of Nursing.**
2. Apply for admission to the College of Nursing (everyone) by completing and submitting the online application at: <http://nursing.fsu.edu/Apply-to-FSU-Nursing>. (refer to the College of Nursing website for deadlines)
3. For non-FSU students, submit official transcripts from all higher education institutions formerly attended to University admissions office at FSU.
4. **We must receive your transcripts prior to the application deadline. Please check the website for updated deadlines for each admit term.**
5. You will receive notice of your admission decision after the interview process, approximately 8 weeks after the deadline by e-mail only.
6. Students are responsible for checking your MyFSU account for updates to your University Admissions application.

Common Back-up Majors for Nursing

- **Psychology**
 - Small major, lots of flexibility with psychology electives, 2.8 GPA
 - STA 2122 required for major (not STA 2023) – can take once in major
 - No extra classes needed as pre-reqs (Nursing pre-reqs cover them all with BSC taken)
 - Foreign language through 2220 series (3rd class)-skip classes with placement exam/CLEP
 - Most classes limited to majors only until reserves lifted (except SOP 3004/PSB 2000)
- **Family and Child Sciences**
 - Not limited access, working with families and children in a variety of settings
 - 4 pre-reqs: CHD 2220/FAD 2230/CHD 3243/FAD 3343 –also the Child Development minor
- **Communication Science Disorders**
 - Speech pathology/audiology
 - Limited access, competitive with GPA, spring deadline parallels Nursing
 - Nursing pre-reqs cover their pre-reqs (must have both chemistry and biology)
- **Social Work**
 - Limited access, but not competitive, 1 extra year for Master's degree
 - 3.0 GPA and 2 extra pre-reqs: POS 1041/PUPX002 and ECO 2000/2013/2023
 - Also Sociology class must be SYG1000/2010 or SYO 3100
 - Can finish pre-reqs summer before and still start in fall program (July 1st deadline)
- **Criminology**
 - Not limited access, no pre-reqs, classes limited to “majors only” except CCJ 2020 online
- **Education**
 - Elementary Education, English Education, Social Science Education, Special Education (Exceptional Student Education) and Visual Disabilities
 - All BS to MS programs only
 - All limited access, some more competitive than others
 - Complete all general education requirements or AA degree
 - One extra pre-req – EDF 1005 (also finish computers, speech, one diversity)
 - MUST see Education advisor early to make sure meeting requirements and receive information about General Knowledge Exam, application, timeline, etc.
- **Social Sciences: International Affairs (IA), Sociology, Interdisciplinary Social Sciences (ISS)**
 - IA: Languages, cultures, global issues, international nonprofits
 - Extensive course options, no pre-reqs, term 4 milestone IA class
 - Sociology: 2 pre-reqs (SYA, SYD, SYG, SYO, SYP), not limited access, 2.0 GPA, small major
 - ISS: 2 pre-reqs from SS discipline, many course choices, 2.0 GPA, no language
- **Health and Pre-Medical**
 - Athletic Training (Pre: AT/PT/PA/Medical), Biological Science, Chemistry, Dietetics/Food and Nutrition, Exercise Physiology, IMS, Neuroscience
 - AT track of Athletic training limited access, application spring sophomore year/Term 4
 - All will require more science courses with labs (extra chemistry?), maybe math
 - Can work as back-up with careful planning and extra summer coursework
 - **Public Health**
