Application Process:

- 1. Apply for admission to Florida State University three months prior to the College of Nursing application deadline at <u>www.admissons.fsu.edu</u> as a transfer student (for non-FSU students). You do not have to be admitted to the University to apply to the College of Nursing.
- Apply for admission to the College of Nursing (everyone) by completing and submitting the online application at: <u>http://nursing.fsu.edu/Apply-to-FSU-Nursing</u>. (refer to the College of Nursing website for deadlines)
- 3. For non-FSU students, submit official transcripts from all higher education institutions formerly attended to University admissions office at FSU.
- 4. We must receive your transcripts prior to the application deadline. Please check the website for updated deadlines for each admit term.
- 5. You will receive notice of your admission decision after the interview process, approximately 8 weeks after the deadline by <u>e-mail only</u>.
- 6. Students are responsible for checking your MyFSU account for updates to your University Admissions application.
