**TITLE:                   ACADEMIC ACCOMMODATIONS FOR STUDENTS WITH DISABILITIES**

**POLICY:**           In accordance with University policy, any student in need of specific services and reasonable accommodations should contact the Student Disability Resource Center (SDRC). Persons with disabilities must be evaluated by this office for clearance before special accommodations can be provided. Students must inform the faculty member of the course and work out the necessary details. , Students with disabilities needing academic accommodation should (1) register with and provide documentation to the Student Disability Resource Center; and bring a letter to the instructor indicating the need for accommodation and what type. Instructors are not allowed to provide classroom accommodation to a student until appropriate verification from the Student Disability Resource Center has been provided.
